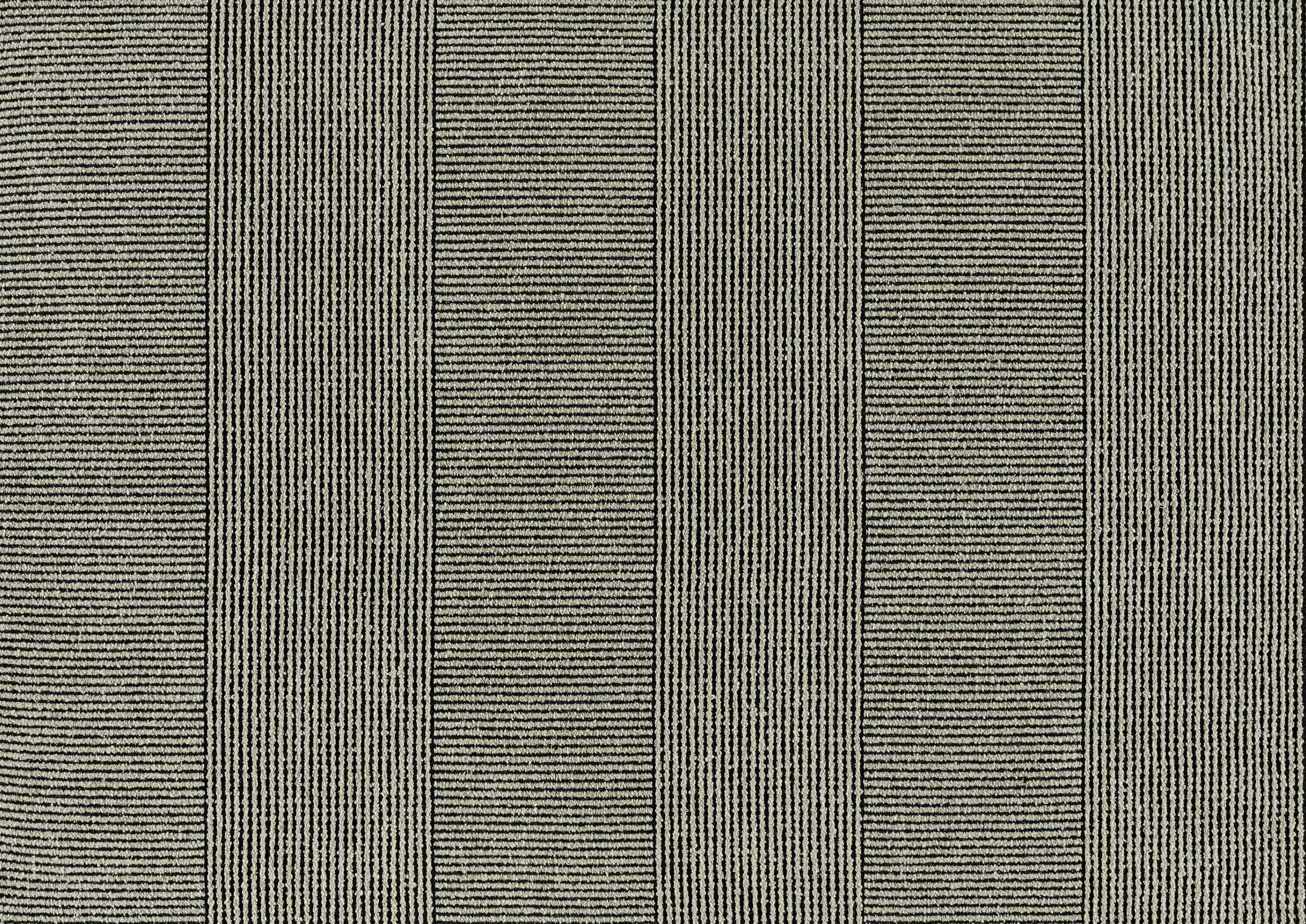

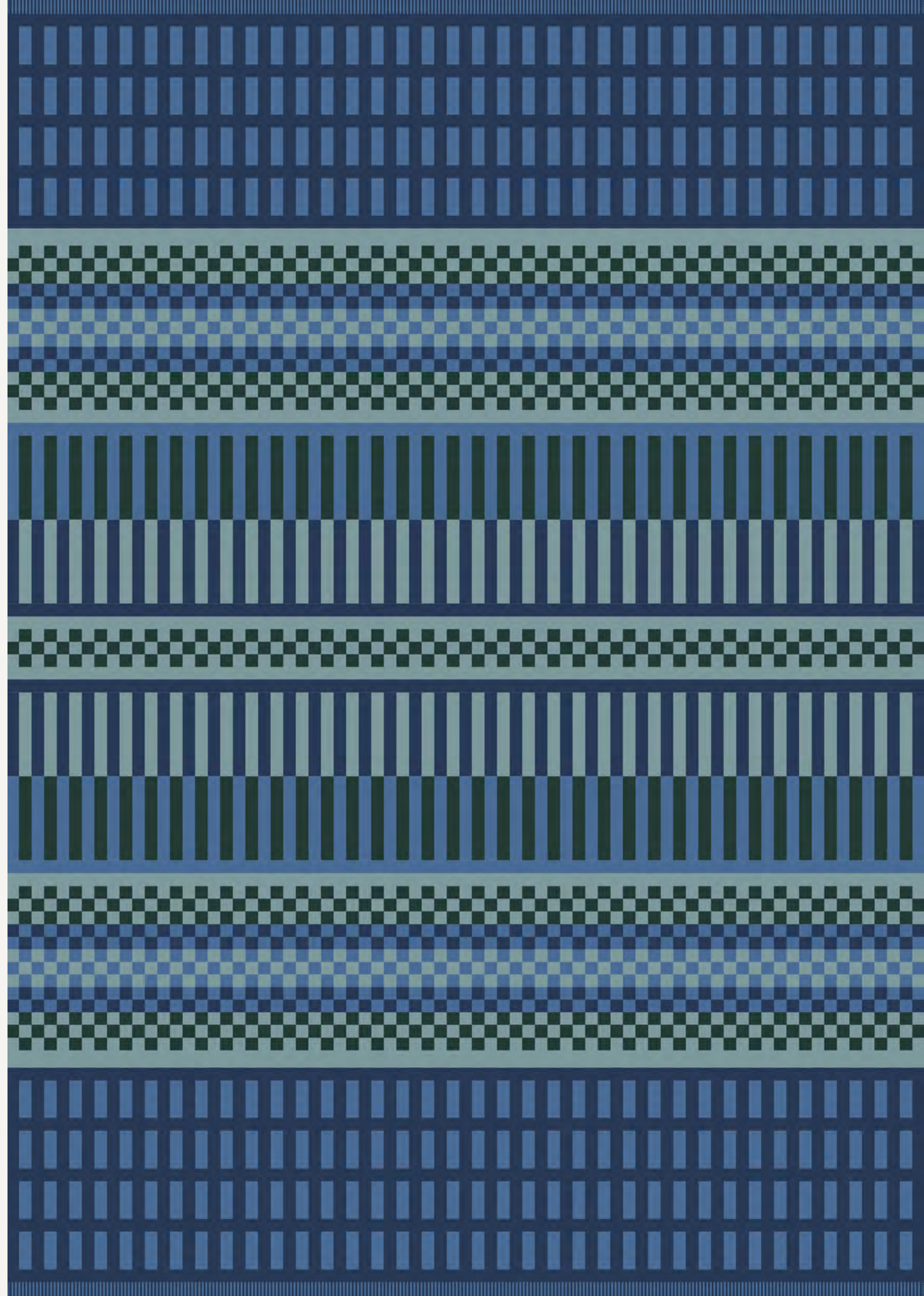
THE HEART AND SOUL *of* KASTHALL

Sustainability In Our Heart *since 1889*

Sustainability and social responsibility have been woven into Kasthall's identity from the beginning. More than 130 years ago, our support of the local community, including neighbouring dyehouses and suppliers, established a foundation of responsibility that continues to guide us today. From the careful selection of raw materials to the precision of our manufacturing process and the safety of the workers in our supply chain, we strive to minimize our impact at every stage.

We want to create rugs that are not only beautiful and durable but also responsibly made, always questioning how our processes can better serve our planet, our community and our customers.



MAKING SUSTAINABLE CHOICES

As a creator and manufacturer of physical items, we understand that the choices we make can have a profound effect on the environment and people. From the careful selection of raw materials to the efficiency of our manufacturing chain and the safety of workers in our supply chain, we strive to choose wisely and improve the impact of our operations in every possible way. To ensure this happens, Kasthall has developed and applied a sustainability strategy with five defined focus areas.

1 | CONSCIOUS CONSUMPTION

Driven by Swedish craftsmanship, we create rugs that are designed to offer many lifetimes of use and pleasure. We do this through a commitment to timeless design and the practice of high quality in all aspects of creation, production and service. Our expertise and experience allows us to offer qualified care advice, enabling longer product life.

- **TIMELESS DESIGN** – Kasthall rugs offer appeal that spans design eras, trends and generations.
- **HIGH QUALITY** – carefully selected materials and refined weaving and tufting techniques allow us to offer a 10-year warranty on every rug.
- **PROPER CARE** – care and cleaning are simple and we provide clear instructions on how this is done with every rug sold.

2 | PRESERVING NATURAL RESOURCES

No rug in the world should come at the cost of polluting nature or diminishing biodiversity. Kasthall has developed an approach to natural resources and their consumption that covers the following areas.

Fiber Selection

The natural raw materials used in our rugs – linen and wool – are produced under conditions designed to protect nature. Our French linen is farmed according to Masters of Linen™ and European Flax™ standards with minimal pesticide use and no irrigation. 95% of our wool is sourced from New Zealand, a country with a long-standing tradition of wool farming and respect for animal health.

Waste Reduction

The Kasthall business model is designed to minimize waste. Since we produce mostly to order and through a meticulous 9-step quality control process, our rugs almost never become waste and we have a reclamation rate of 0.5%, including products damaged in transport. The few rugs that do come back to us, and those that never leave the factory due to quality issues, are sold in our factory store. In our factory, we systematically reduce waste by using residual yarn for special rugs and by recycling warp.

Use of water and chemicals

Our factory in Kinna does not use water or chemicals and we do not bleach any of our yarn. However, the yarn dyeing process that bring our colors to life does require their use.

- All the yarns we use arrive at our factory with an OEKO-Tex 100 certification.
- We only use local dyehouses to minimize environmental impact.
- Our dyehouses only use chemicals that fulfil the strict EU chemical legislation REACH.
- All our rugs are tested for chemical emissions including VOCs.
- Kasthall is in an ongoing process to identify and use chemicals that have less impact on the environment.



Harvest and Flourish Rugs

Every time we make a rug, we are left with a few surplus yarn spools intended to cover any potential quality issues. To further reduce our use of natural resources and minimize waste, we used this surplus yarn to create the award-winning rugs Harvest and Flourish, turning what would otherwise be production waste into sustainable luxury.

Recycled Wool

It has long been our ambition to use recycled wool and linen in our rugs. After years of hard work, we're about to launch of our first rug collection made from recycled wool – Fasad, a collaboration with acclaimed architect David Chipperfield.

- The reclaimed wool's primary properties are restored, transforming it back into high-quality material.
- The recycled wool fibers are spun into new, durable yarns, ready to be woven into rugs designed to last for generations.
- Thanks to the natural keratin structure of wool and its tough, water-repellent membrane, these fibers remain strong and resilient, even after recycling.
- The wool yarn is spun from 25% recycled fibres and 75% virgin fibres to ensure Kasthall's high quality standards are maintained.
- Reclaiming the wool is a completely European recycling process that reduces the need for new resources.

3 | CLIMATE PROTECTION

At Kasthall, we support the goals of the Paris Agreement and align with the latest climate science. In 2024, ambitious reduction targets were approved by the Science Based Target initiative.

Scope 1 and 2 Emissions

In terms of scope 1 and 2 emissions, our impact is relatively small for a company of our size and is mostly generated by company cars, the electricity and heating used in our offices and stores, our warehouse and the knitting and tufting processes in our factory. Emissions are low because we have optimized our machines to reduce energy consumption and switched to renewable and low-emission electricity sources. Our aim is to reduce our Scope 1 and Scope 2 emissions by 50% by 2030 and looking further into the future, we will strive to achieve zero emissions.

Scope 3 Emissions

The majority of our emissions, 85%, occur outside our own operations. These come from the production of wool and linen, spinning and dyeing of yarn and transportation of materials. It is our aim to reduce Scope 3 emissions by 52%, relative to value added, by 2030. We plan to achieve this by sourcing fibers with lower emissions and working with our suppliers to encourage the implementation of renewable energy and energy-efficient production methods.

4 | CARING FOR PEOPLE

At Kasthall, we are fully aware that people are our most valuable asset. As such, we aim to be attractive employers and responsible partners in terms of how we treat workers in our supply chain. This involves always respecting human rights and promoting healthy and safe working conditions and inclusive workplaces.

OUR TARGETS IN THIS AREA ARE WELL-DEFINED

- We aim to achieve zero accidents in our own operations.
- We will publish an updated Code of Conduct.
- We will require 100% of suppliers to report on their social practices.
- We will introduce a Kasthall employee satisfaction survey.

5 | GOOD GOVERNANCE

We conduct systematic due diligence of our impact on the planet and people with the aim of managing this through policies, initiatives, targets and clear governance. Looking forward, it is our intention to introduce even higher levels of transparency and accountability into our operations.

To help us achieve our governance aims, we have established and implemented a defined sustainability strategy with clear targets, metrics and action plans. To date, our achievements include establishing public policies and public due diligence practices and continuously ensuring our employees are trained in the latest sustainability issues and practices.

Color is key to releasing the inherent beauty of the material in our rugs. To understand the complex nature of the relationship between color and material demands a deep understanding of color theory and how its properties affect perception. By constantly creating new expressions and nuances, Kasthall's designers can justifiably claim to be *masters of color*.

There is no doubt that color has a profound effect on how we perceive the world around us. In the last century of interior design, it has been at the heart of some of the period's most defining movements. From the color theory of the Bauhaus era and its focus on simple forms and functionality through the Art Deco period. From 1960's experimentation to 1970's minimalism and the reaction to this in the 1980's – in many ways, color has been the visual calling card of these, and many other eras of design.

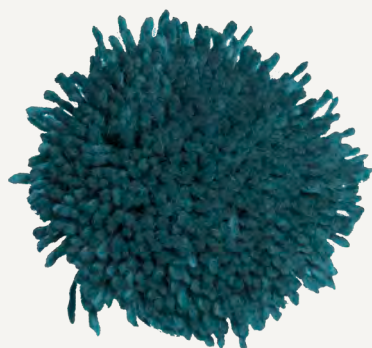


WHEN HISTORY MEETS THE THRILL *of* RIGHT NOW

The samples in this room may be finite in number, but the ideas and knowledge they've generated over the decades are not. However, it's what it continues to do that makes our archive special.

The Kasthall design archive has helped us achieve mastery of color that goes beyond creating simple hues and applying warm, cool or neutral tones. Whether we're designing rugs with a monochromatic, analogous or triadic color palette, our archive has shown us how color can convey feelings that range from precious and delicate to expressive and powerful. It's taught us how to use dye subtly but with impact and how and where color should express itself in the rug. It's shown us how combining colors to create mottled yarn releases patterns and visually lifts structure. It's helped us discover how linen and wool playfully interact - and it contains literally thousands of examples of how scale and size affect color perception.



Color can be profoundly affected by the type of rug being created. Kasthall creates both tufted and woven rugs, and here you can see how the yarn's color profile subtly changes depending on how it is cut.



While we respect our past, the focus of our designers is very much on the future. It's our responsibility to ensure Kasthall rugs maintain their exquisite balance of timeless elegance and contemporary relevance. To achieve this, we'll continue to explore the deep connection we've created with color and its defining role in rug design. Our creative team will embrace the use of new, sustainable materials and be inspired by the possibilities these offer. And we'll remain committed to the journey of discovery that's made us Masters of Color.

Designed by Cecilie Manz, it features a sophisticated 22-degree diagonal pattern created using a cut and loop pile technique – a design element that sets it apart. This composition results in a subtle, gentle expression, further enhanced by its two different heights, contributing to its refined appearance.

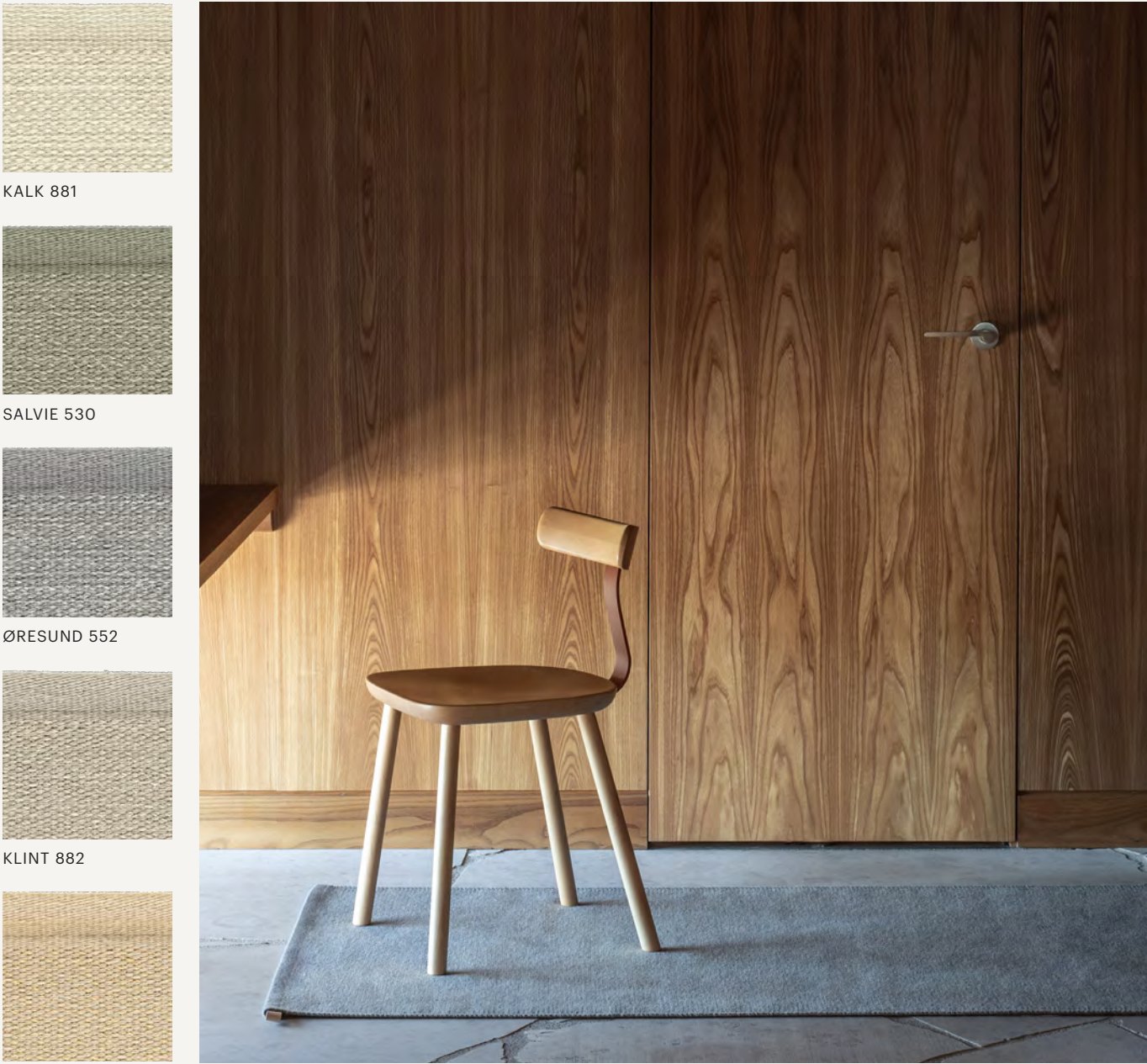

Crafted from wool and linen, Ålegræs is a hand-tufted rug in a unique oval shape designed by Cecilie Manz. Ålegræs features three different pile heights that create a seagrass-like texture with a three-dimensional effect. Drawing inspiration from the intricate beauty of nature, it has a lively surface framed by a contrasting bouclé border that adds bold definition and elegance.

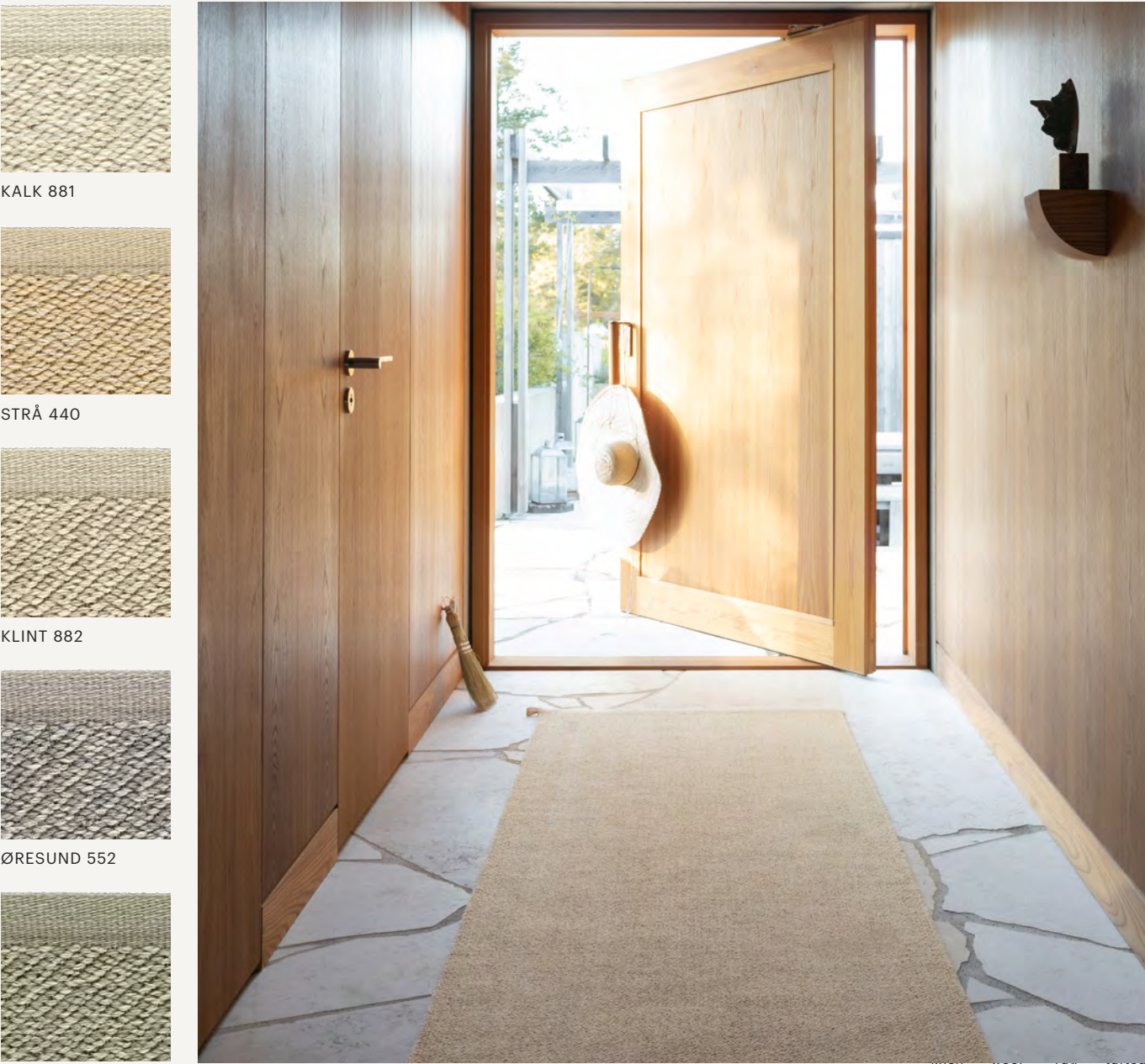


Designed by internationally acclaimed Danish designer Cecilie Manz, Gryn is a thin, light, flatwoven rug that combines wool and linen in a new effect yarn, specially developed for the Landskab collection. This combination of twisted wool and linen creates shimmering pearls on the surface when light shines on the linen yarn. While the rug may appear even from a distance, it reveals a textured surface filled with intricate details up close.

Korn is a flatwoven rug in a broken twill pattern, designed by Cecilie Manz as part of the Landskab collection. It uses a unique wavy-effect yarn with threads of wool and linen running parallel. Developed specially for this collection to achieve a particular texture, this new yarn highlights the natural beauty of linen on the rug's surface, resulting in a lustrous finish that elevates its depth and overall appeal.

Designed by the Pritzker Prize-winning architect David Chipperfield, the Tegel collection is a family of hand-tufted bouclé rugs in wool and linen. The wool gives depth, warmth, and volume. The linen adds a discrete and vibrant note to the overall texture. Tegel is composed of three design variants Corner, Side, and Centre each displaying three color areas in separate (but related)

spatial configurations affecting the perception of the surrounding. The design of Tegel reflects a marriage between past, present, and future – paying homage to the knowledge and culture at Kasthall while incorporating the naturally weathered variations of the historic brick buildings at Kasthall’s headquarters and factory. Each design variant comes in seven different colorways.

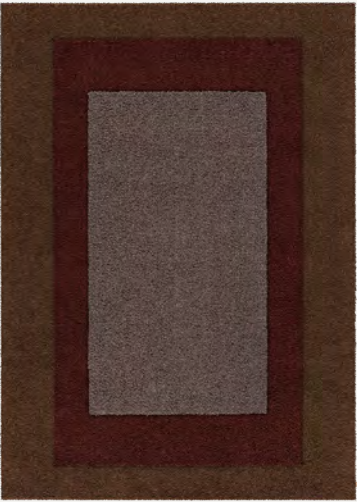

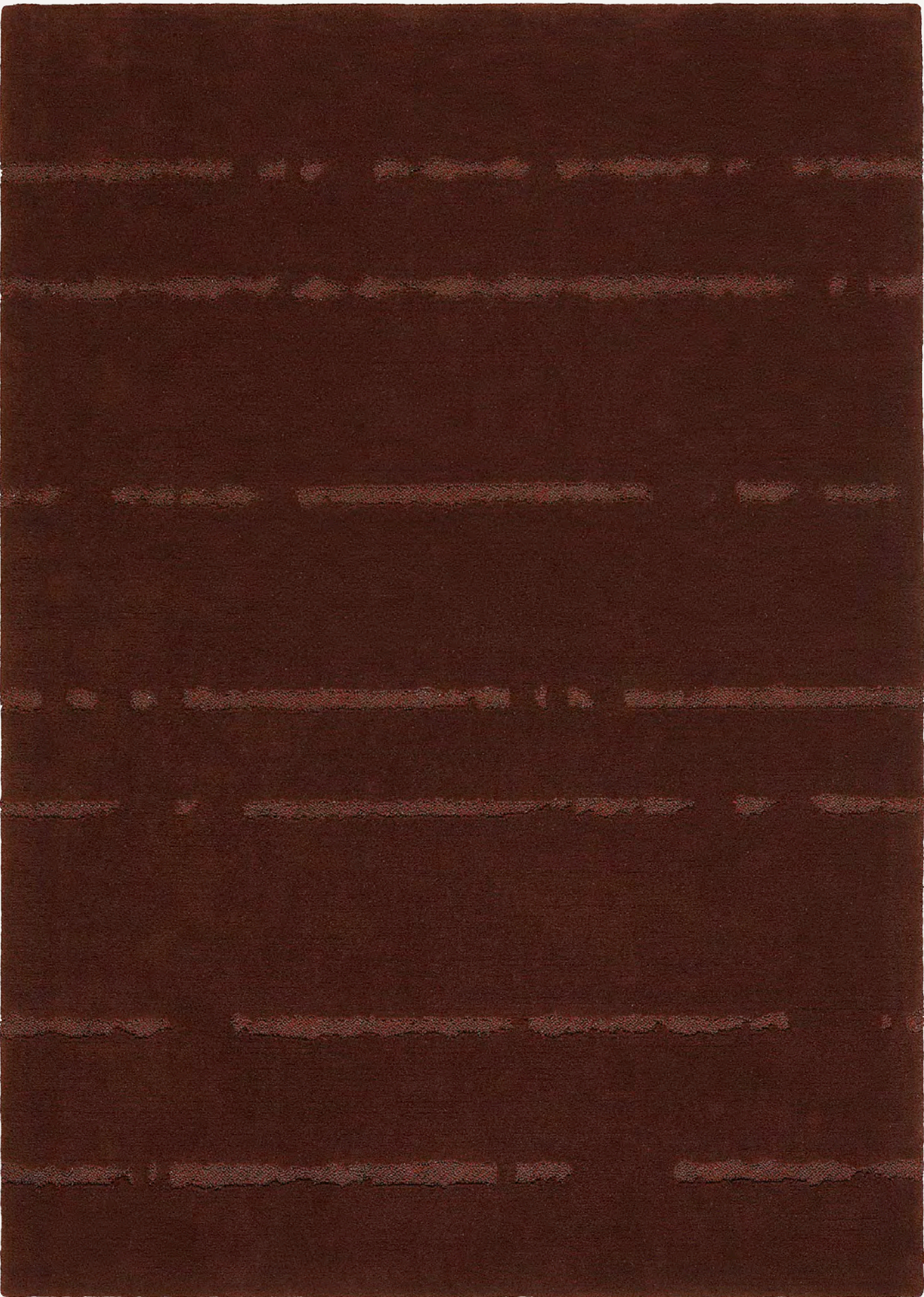


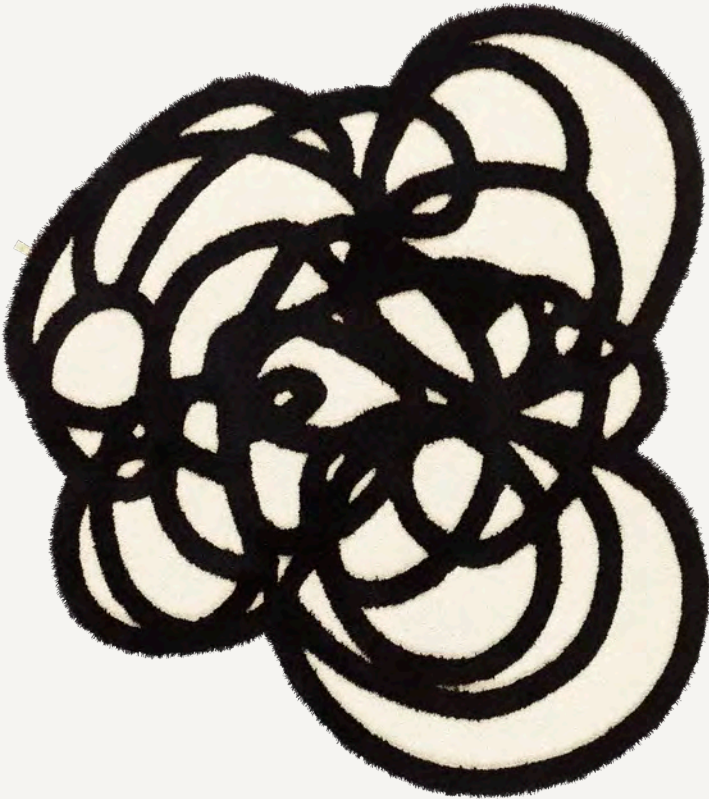
PINSTRIPE XL

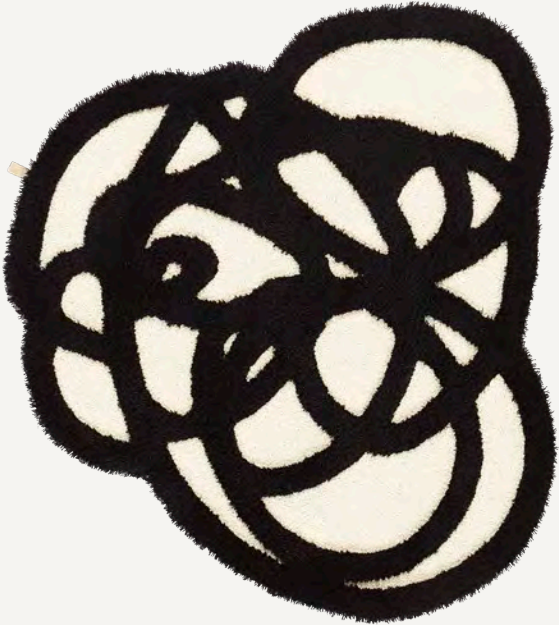


Pinstripe XL is designed by the Swedish design trio Claesson Koivisto Rune. The original pattern was launched in 2007 as a woven rug for the renowned restaurant Operakällaren in Stockholm. In 2010, the collection was reinvigorated with an enlarged hand-tufted version made in wool and linen – Pinstripe XL. The most notable change in the updated version is the hand-drawn pinstripes, enlarged and enhanced with linen and bouclé wool, while the base color is in 100% wool.

Doodle is a hand-tufted long-pile rug in wool and linen designed by Paola Navone. Creativity stretched to its limits; it is a rug with no exact shape, designed with quick hands and thick brushstrokes. The result is Doodle, out of scale in black on white, like ink on paper.

Created by Ilse Crawford, Ängsmark is a light and hand-woven rug in pure wool that mixes lines of chenille to create its beautiful geometric pattern. Using over-dyed mélange yarns, developed explicitly for the Grönska collection, the rug aims to reflect the varying colors of Swedish nature. To further enhance this effect, white hair yarn is interwoven with the mélange yarn, appearing irregularly across the rug's surface.

Feather is a tufted rug in pure wool and linen bouclé. With its feather-like fringes, this rug is a standout piece, featuring soft structures that resembles the chest of a bird. It is an ideal centerpiece in any interior design.

KASTHALL

Ingrid Dessau was a pioneer in Sweden's modern textile and design history, known for her unique perspective and exceptional talent. With roots in the southern Swedish folk crafts tradition, she studied textiles and worked as a designer, developing patterns for rugs, fabrics, and embroideries. Ingrid was as much an innovator as she was a creator. She always welcomed new ideas, whether they were about developing Kasthall's visual language or embracing new weaving techniques. Ingrid worked at Kasthall for almost 25 years, between 1954–1978. It is impossible to think of Kasthall's rug factory in Kinna during this period without also thinking of Ingrid Dessau from Svalöv.

TRIMMINGS

Binding

When binding the edge of an area rug we place a 30 mm polyester strip, of which about 15 mm becomes visible, along the edge of the rug. Color matched to the rug or contrasting color by request.



























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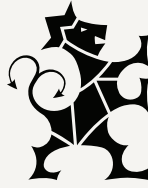
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
