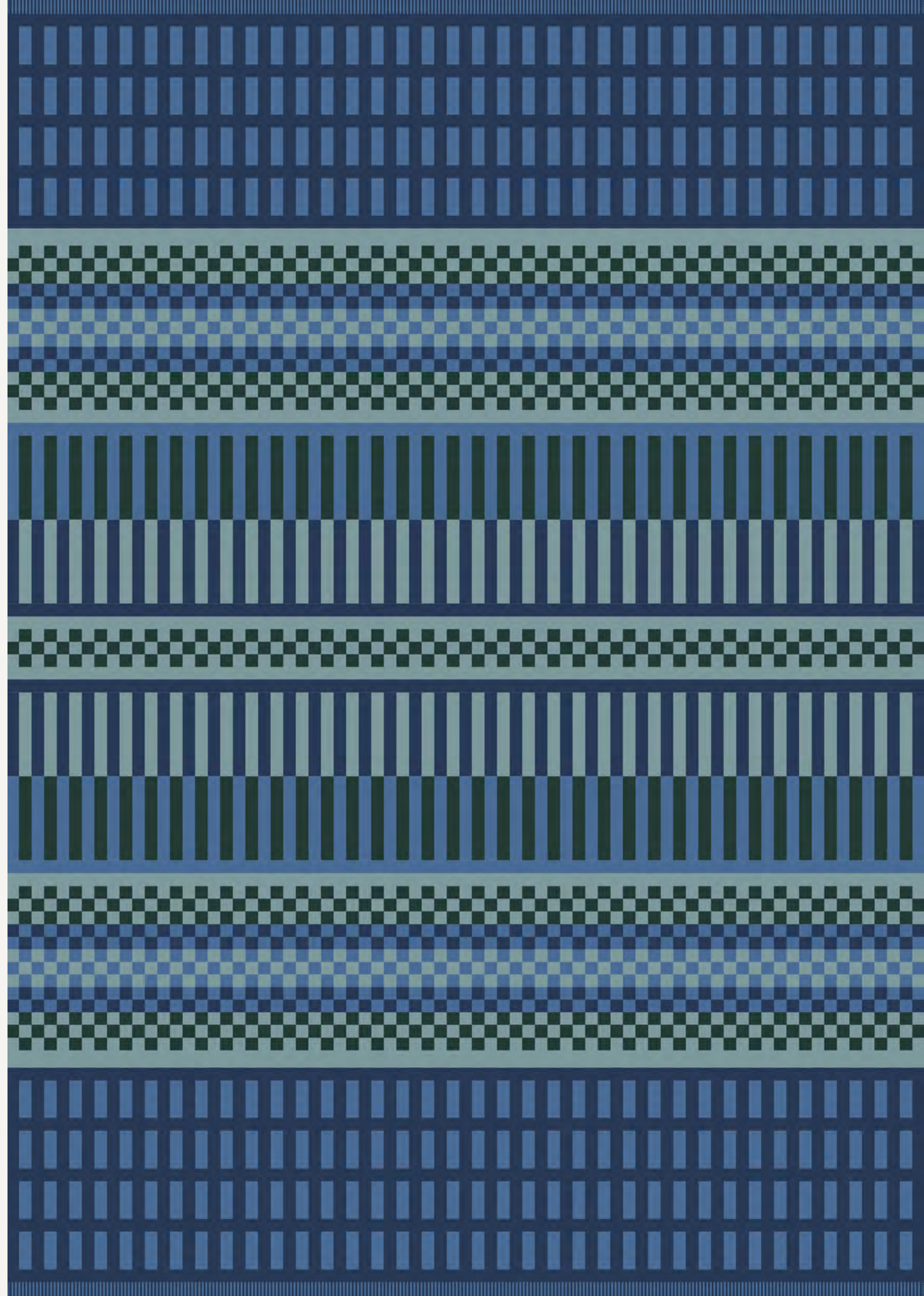
KASTHALL

MASTERS *of* COLOR

KASTHALL

Color is key to releasing the inherent beauty of the material in our rugs. To understand the complex nature of the relationship between color and material demands a deep understanding of color theory and how its properties affect perception. By constantly creating new expressions and nuances, Kasthall's designers can justifiably claim to be *masters of color*.

There is no doubt that color has a profound effect on how we perceive the world around us. In the last century of interior design, it has been at the heart of some of the period's most defining movements. From the color theory of the Bauhaus era and its focus on simple forms and functionality through the Art Deco period. From 1960's experimentation to 1970's minimalism and the reaction to this in the 1980's – in many ways, color has been the visual calling card of these, and many other eras of design.

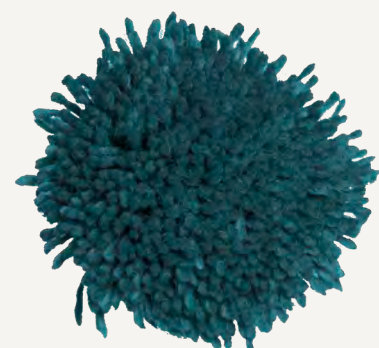


WHEN HISTORY MEETS THE THRILL *of* RIGHT NOW

However we choose to see it, the archive in our design studio is home to a legacy of breathtaking diversity. In here, you'll find much more than the physical proof of over 130 years of creativity. The samples in this room may be finite in number, but the ideas and knowledge they've generated over the decades are not. However, it's what it continues to do that makes our archive special.

The Kasthall design archive has helped us achieve mastery of color that goes beyond creating simple hues and applying warm, cool or neutral tones. Whether we're designing rugs with a monochromatic, analogous or triadic color palette, our archive has shown us how color can convey feelings that range from precious and delicate to expressive and powerful. It's taught us how to use dye subtly but with impact and how and where color should express itself in the rug. It's shown us how combining colors to create mottled yarn releases patterns and visually lifts structure. It's helped us discover how linen and wool playfully interact - and it contains literally thousands of examples of how scale and size affect color perception.



Color can be profoundly affected by the type of rug being created. Kasthall creates both tufted and woven rugs, and here you can see how the yarn's color profile subtly changes depending on how it is cut.



While we respect our past, the focus of our designers is very much on the future. It's our responsibility to ensure Kasthall rugs maintain their exquisite balance of timeless elegance and contemporary relevance. To achieve this, we'll continue to explore the deep connection we've created with color and its defining role in rug design. Our creative team will embrace the use of new, sustainable materials and be inspired by the possibilities these offer. And we'll remain committed to the journey of discovery that's made us Masters of Color.

RUG AND ROOM

A Timeless Relationship

Crafted and tactile, humancentric and bold – wherever they're found, Kasthall rugs convey warmth and beauty, creating inviting spaces that nurture human connections and feelings of well-being. To fully enjoy this, here are some tips for placing a rug in a home.

EFFECTFUL PLACING

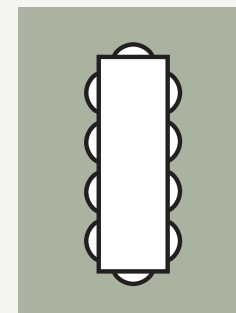
Rugs are very often the visual anchor of a space, serving the purpose of bonding together other design cues and furnishings as well as complementing paintwork or wallpaper choices. They also help define the floor plan and guide the placement of furniture.

BEFORE PLACING, HERE ARE SOME QUESTIONS YOU SHOULD CONSIDER.

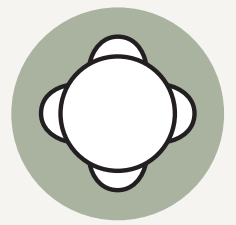
- How do people move around in the room?
- How many items of furniture are in the room and where will they be placed in relation to the rug?
- How are the room's acoustics and how will the rug affect noise insulation?
- How will light, both natural and artificial, affect perception of the rug's color and structure?

WITH TABLE AND CHAIRS

- Make sure the rug is of a scale that ensures all the chairs are still on the rug even when they are fully pulled out.
- To ensure this, we recommend a rug that is 50–60cm larger than the table in both length and width.

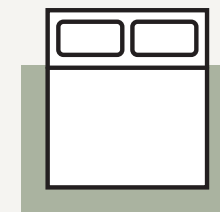

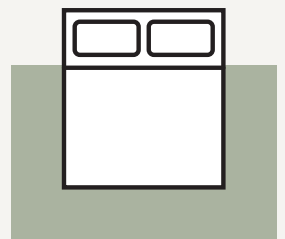


IN A BEDROOM

- When placing, focus on creating a unified look between bed and rug.
- Most of the rug should be under the bed, so we recommend choosing a rug that is at least 60cm larger than the bed in both length and width.



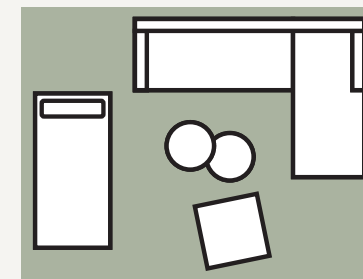

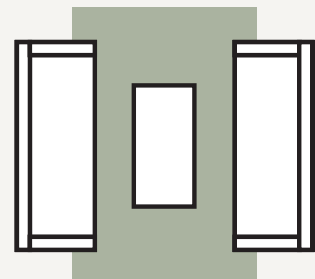

AS PART OF A SOFA GROUP

- Ensure your rug is at least as wide as the sofa.
- Create a unified aesthetic by ensuring part of the rug is under the sofa.
- If the group includes armchairs, choose a rug that is large enough to ensure all four legs of each armchair stay on the rug.

Sustainability In Our Heart *since* 1889



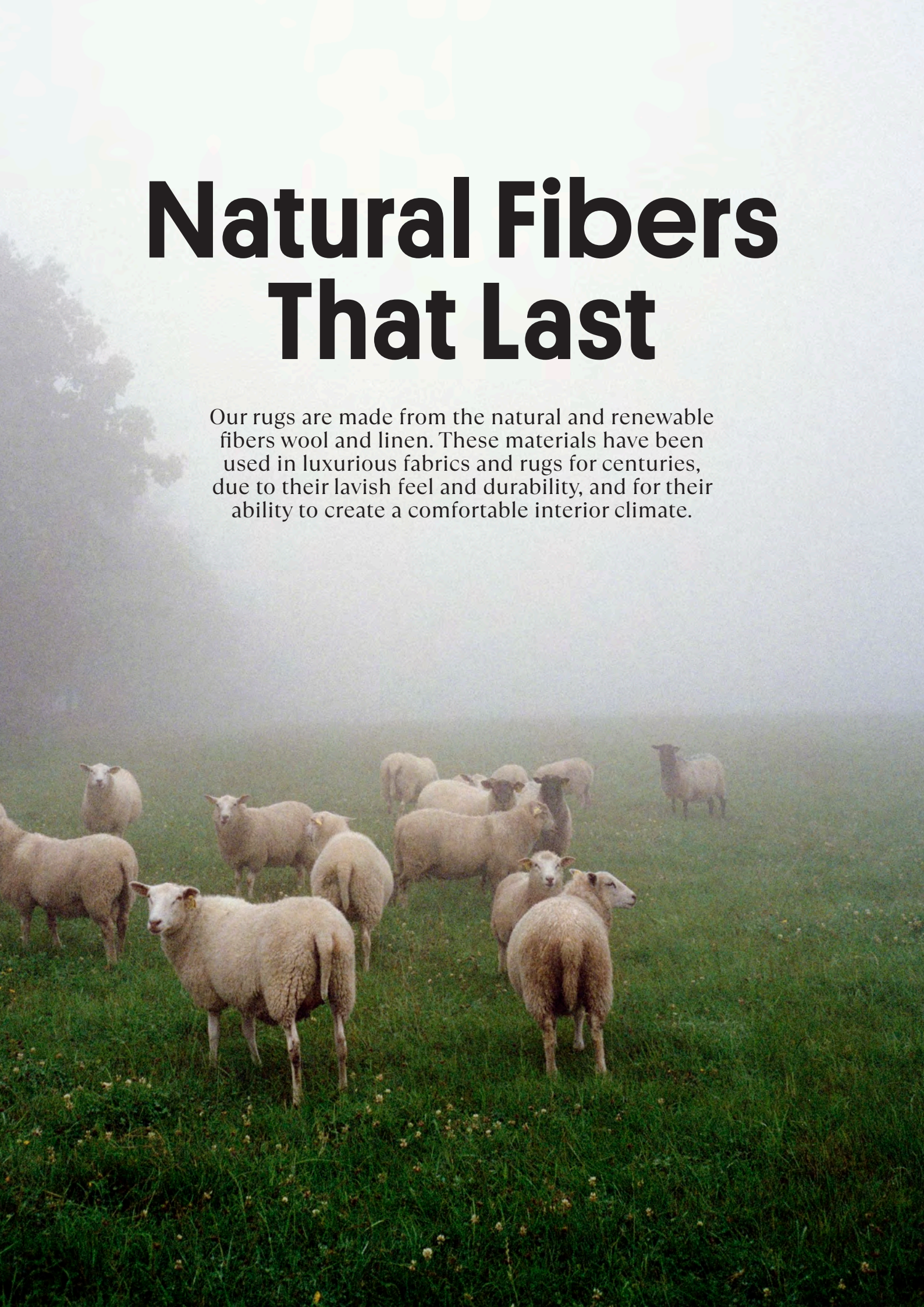
No-one used terms like sustainability or social responsibility back then, but since 1889, they've been part of the Kasthall story. Supporting the local community, including neighbouring dyehouses and suppliers, established a way of working and thinking that continues to guide us today.

That we are so strongly connected to our surroundings might not come as such a surprise if you visit our iconic head office in Kinna, Sweden. Outside our door, a backdrop of green fields spreads out and the seemingly ageless River Häggå meanders by, reminding us every day of our place in the world and our responsibility to both Nordic and global society.

Skilled artisans at heart, we still design, innovate and create every Kasthall rug from this special location – and with good reason. Call it magic, spirit or whatever you like, but we believe the fresh air, green grass, trees and clear river water that surround us here in Kinna live in every fiber of every rug that leaves our factory.

Natural Fibers That Last

Our rugs are made from the natural and renewable fibers wool and linen. These materials have been used in luxurious fabrics and rugs for centuries, due to their lavish feel and durability, and for their ability to create a comfortable interior climate.



Wool ೀೀೀ

95% of our wool comes from New Zealand, known for the highest quality wool farming, with long, strong fibers that do not break ensuring the durability of our rugs.

The wool farming in New Zealand has a long tradition of respect for animal rights and is increasingly implementing modern techniques of farming to reduce environmental impact.

As a further step towards reducing our impact, we would like to be able to source our wool closer to home, something that is not possible today due to quality issues. We are therefore supporting various projects aimed at rebuilding the Swedish wool industry.

All our linen and wool yarn are sourced from trusted suppliers in France, Italy and Germany who we have worked with for decades and who can meet our very strict specifications.



Linen ೀೀೀ

100% of our linen comes from France and is certified according to Masters of Linen™ and European Flax™. This ensures that the fibers are produced through farming that is respectful of the environment, without irrigation or GMO.

It also means that the fibers are separated from the core and skin of the flax plant using traditional dew retting, in contrast to water or chemical retting used in other regions of the world. And that the fiber extraction is 100% mechanical and with zero waste.

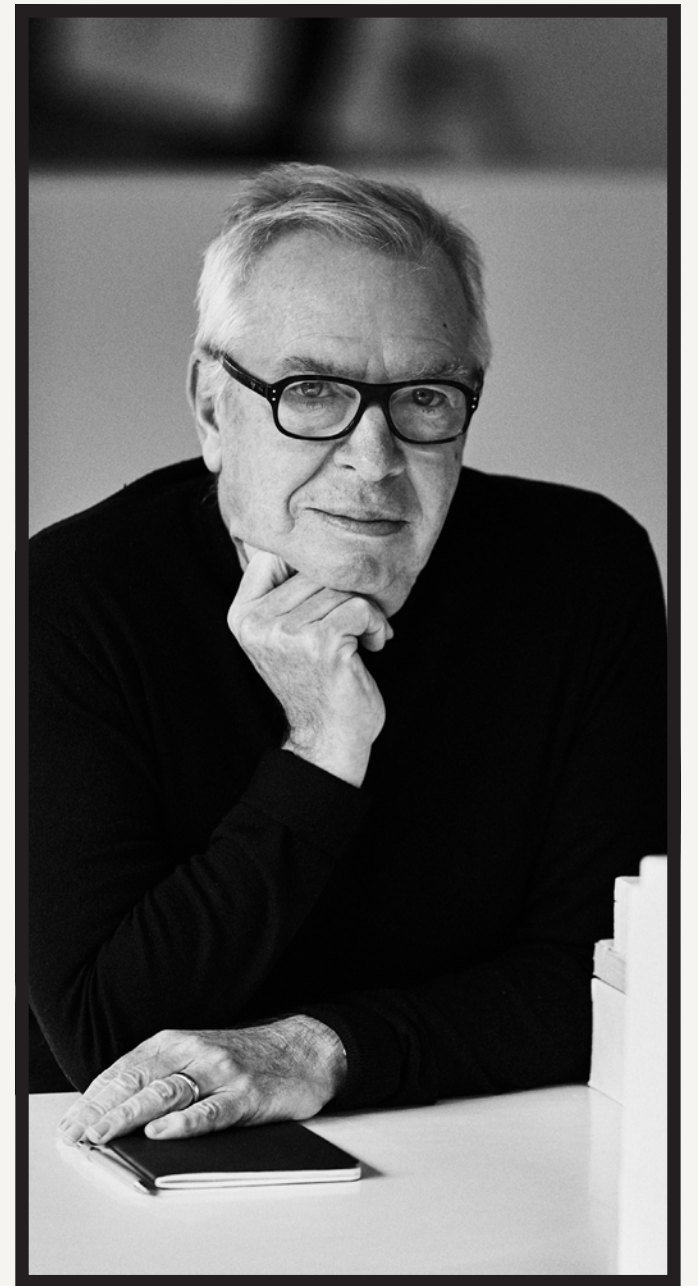

Spire is a soft, tactile hand-tufted rug crafted from wool and linen. Designed by Cecilie Manz, it features a sophisticated 22-degree diagonal pattern created using a cut and loop pile technique – a design element that sets it apart. This composition results in a subtle, gentle expression, further enhanced by its two different heights, contributing to its refined appearance.

Crafted from wool and linen, Ålegræs is a hand-tufted rug in a unique oval shape designed by Cecilie Manz. Ålegræs features three different pile heights that create a seagrass-like texture with a three-dimensional effect. Drawing inspiration from the intricate beauty of nature, it has a lively surface framed by a contrasting bouclé border that adds bold definition and elegance.

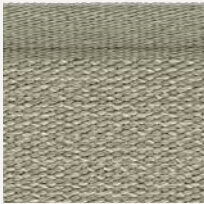

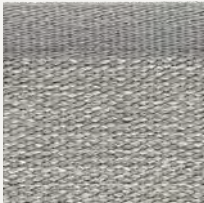

Designed by internationally acclaimed Danish designer Cecilie Manz, Gryn is a thin, light, flatwoven rug that combines wool and linen in a new effect yarn, specially developed for the Landskab collection. This combination of twisted wool and linen creates shimmering pearls on the surface when light shines on the linen yarn. While the rug may appear even from a distance, it reveals a textured surface filled with intricate details up close.

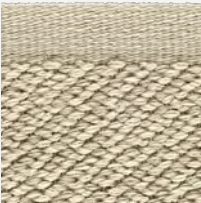

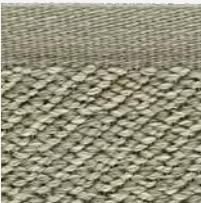

Korn is a flatwoven rug in a broken twill pattern, designed by Cecilie Manz as part of the Landskab collection. It uses a unique wavy-effect yarn with threads of wool and linen running parallel. Developed specially for this collection to achieve a particular texture, this new yarn highlights the natural beauty of linen on the rug's surface, resulting in a lustrous finish that elevates its depth and overall appeal.

Designed by the Pritzker Prize-winning architect David Chipperfield, the Tegel collection is a family of hand-tufted bouclé rugs in wool and linen. The wool gives depth, warmth, and volume. The linen adds a discrete and vibrant note to the overall texture. Tegel is composed of three design variants Corner, Side, and Centre each displaying three color areas in separate (but related)

spatial configurations affecting the perception of the surrounding. The design of Tegel reflects a marriage between past, present, and future – paying homage to the knowledge and culture at Kasthall while incorporating the naturally weathered variations of the historic brick buildings at Kasthall’s headquarters and factory. Each design variant comes in seven different colorways.

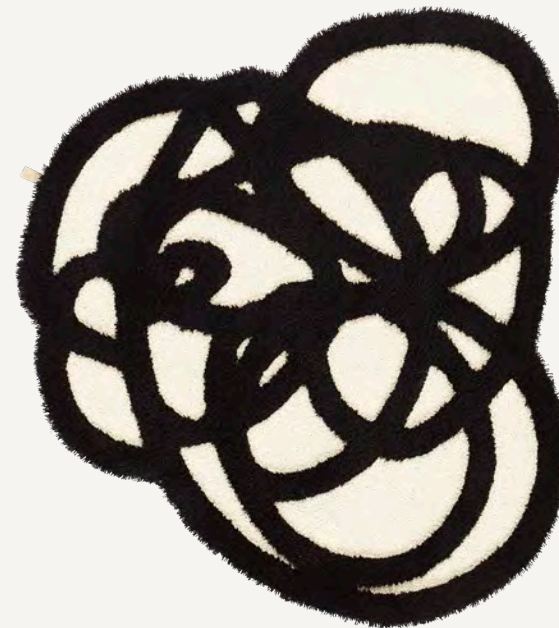


Pinstripe XL is designed by the Swedish design trio Claesson Koivisto Rune. The original pattern was launched in 2007 as a woven rug for the renowned restaurant Operakällaren in Stockholm. In 2010, the collection was reinvigorated with an enlarged hand-tufted version made in wool and linen – Pinstripe XL. The most notable change in the updated version is the hand-drawn pinstripes, enlarged and enhanced with linen and bouclé wool, while the base color is in 100% wool.

Doodle is a hand-tufted long-pile rug in wool and linen designed by Paola Navone. Creativity stretched to its limits; it is a rug with no exact shape, designed with quick hands and thick brushstrokes. The result is Doodle, out of scale in black on white, like ink on paper.

Created by Ilse Crawford, Ängsmark is a light and hand-woven rug in pure wool that mixes lines of chenille to create its beautiful geometric pattern. Using over-dyed mélangé yarns, developed explicitly for the Grönska collection, the rug aims to reflect the varying colors of Swedish nature. To further enhance this effect, white hair yarn is interwoven with the mélangé yarn, appearing irregularly across the rug's surface.

When Kasthall Design Studio made the decision to relaunch the classic pattern Checkerboard, much time was spent on research to find just the right color combinations. The four different color combinations have drawn inspiration from the Scandinavian color palette, thus more subtle tones such as grey-green and light blue, but with the addition of two more contrasting colors such as yellow and midnight black in a checkered contrast to an off-white base. QUEEN *of* NUANCES

KASTHALL

Ingrid Dessau was a pioneer in Sweden's modern textile and design history, known for her unique perspective and exceptional talent. With roots in the southern Swedish folk crafts tradition, she studied textiles and worked as a designer, developing patterns for rugs, fabrics, and embroideries. Ingrid was as much an innovator as she was a creator. She always welcomed new ideas, whether they were about developing Kasthall's visual language or embracing new weaving techniques. Ingrid worked at Kasthall for almost 25 years, between 1954–1978. It is impossible to think of Kasthall's rug factory in Kinna during this period without also thinking of Ingrid Dessau from Svalöv.
